**Local Rules for Spring Run Golf Club**  
**USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY**

- Out of Bounds is defined by the inside edge of white stakes, all roads and fences bordering the golf course, and to include the opposite edge of all water hazards.
- Decorative Flower Areas are to be played as Ground Under Repair. Drop from these areas no closer to the hole. Do not hit from these areas.
- All water hazards are considered lateral with the margin defined by red lines and stakes.
- Preserve on Hole #12 is an Environmentally Sensitive Area. You may NOT enter the Preserve at any time. Play as Lateral Hazard – one stroke penalty (Rule 26-1).
- Embedded ball rule is in effect through the Green.
- Relief from Sprinkler Heads (Rule 24-2): If a ball lies through the green and an immovable obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows: The ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer to the hole, (b) avoids intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.
- If ball comes to rest on, your stance is on, or your swing path is on the coquina cart path not inside the blue staked area you are entitled to free relief under 24-2.
