- · Out of bounds is defined by the inside edge of white stakes, all roads and fences bordering the golf course, and to include the opposite edge of all water hazards.
- Decorative Flower Areas are to be played as ground under repair. Drop from these areas no closer to the hole. Do not hit from these areas.
- All water hazards are considered lateral with the margin defined by red lines / stakes.
- Please fill divots and repair ball marks.
- Unless otherwise posted, please use 90° rule when operating carts.
- Keep carts on paths within 50 yards of tees and greens.
- Carts are to remain on paths on par 3's at all times.
- · Coquina Shell Cart Paths are an integral part of the golf course. The ball shall be played as it lies, no relief permitted.
- Preserve on Hole #12 is an Environmentally Sensitive Area, you may NOT enter the preserve at any time. Play as Lateral Hazard - one stroke penalty (Rule 26-1).
